- Peter R talked about the \$4,000 cheque received from RTOERO and the excellent Christmas Luncheon that RTOERO put on, where Bruce Men's Shed was the guest of honour. Peter, Terry, Don, and Gerry T enjoyed the turkey feast and the great warmth we felt accepting their cheque
- Kudos were given to Sharron Colter for her work on the RTOERO funds!
- Peter also informed us that and that the Municipality of North Bruce Peninsula awarded a \$1,000 grant to us for use in projects
- Owen described some clothing options with our BMS logo on it; T-shirts, hoodies, long sleeves, hats, patches and more are available from Ram Accessories in Wiarton and other locations. When asked an overwhelming majority put up a hand to show interest in purchasing an item at a cost estimate of \$30. We talked about having BMS fund part of this and a number suggested that since we have no membership fees, they are willing to pay the full amount. One request was that the clothing be "men's sized shirts". Agreed!
- Gerry T proposed purchase of an electric branding iron that would burn the BMS logo onto wooden items made by the group. (Not to be used for branding members however). The cost estimate was over \$300 which a show of hand voted to proceed on however after further discussion, a better purchase would be a non-electric brand heated by a propane torch, costing less than \$100 Subsequent to the meeting: we may be able to manufacture our own by skilled members with materials on hand
- New member Paul introduced himself and his recent move to Lions Head, a recently retired teacher who is willing to share his knife sharpening skills
